


Parts of a Journal Article Citation from a Database

Most journal article citations contain the names of the authors, the title of the article, the title of the journal, the year published, the volume number of the journal, the issue number, and the page numbers. You will need this information to create a reference for your reference list if you use information from the article in your paper.

Volume Issue Page Numbers

You need this information to locate articles in print. For example, if you wanted to find a print copy of an article published after 1995 at Morris Library, you would go to the third floor. The journals are shelved alphabetically by title. We cover our journals with hard covers. Each title is arranged on the shelf by volume and by year. You will need the page numbers to locate the article in the volume.



You will also need this some of this information to locate journal articles from a journal's website .

Notice that to find back issue of the European Journal of Physics, You need to know the volume, issue, and year:
